

## Public Law Fellowship 2022

Renne Public Law Group is pleased to offer a condensed fellowship program designed to introduce law students and public administration and public policy graduate students to local government advocacy.

The Fellowship Program will be held remotely for a two-week period: June 13-24, 2022. Fellows will receive a \$2,000 stipend at the conclusion of the program. The deadline for applications is March 4, 2022 by 5:00pm PST.

The Program is designed to be a "crash course" – immersing students in the field of local government law and public policy initiatives. Fellows will gain valuable knowledge in a wide range of law and legal issues unique to local government, including the Brown Act, the Public Records Act, CEQA, the Meyers Miliias-Brown Act, charter law principles and more. The program will include talks with local officials and legal experts, legal research assignments, and discussions about future challenges facing local governments. The program is intended to supplement summer programs at private law firms and government agencies.

To be eligible, students: must have completed their first year of law school but ideally have completed their second year; must demonstrate a serious interest in the local public sector; must have an excellent academic background and possess superior writing skills. Students must commit to spending at least 40 hours a week on the Fellowship. MPA and MPP students must have their first year of graduate school completed and also have a serious interest in local government, an excellent academic background, and possess superior writing skills.
